

Anna Auwae was born and raised in Germany and moved to the USA in 1996. Prior to her move to Colorado, she worked for the U.S. Army Directorate of Engineering & Housing in Baumholder, Germany. Once in the USA, Anna worked for a large utility metering and billing company as a data and quality control manager. She started her career at the Colorado Springs Police Department (CSPD) in 2004 and has been an analyst in CSPD's Planning and Compliance Section since 2008.

In her current role, Anna Auwae performs complex data analyses related to workload, response to calls for service, and resource scheduling; prepares the department's grant applications; conducts benchmark studies and other research; and manages a variety of projects.
